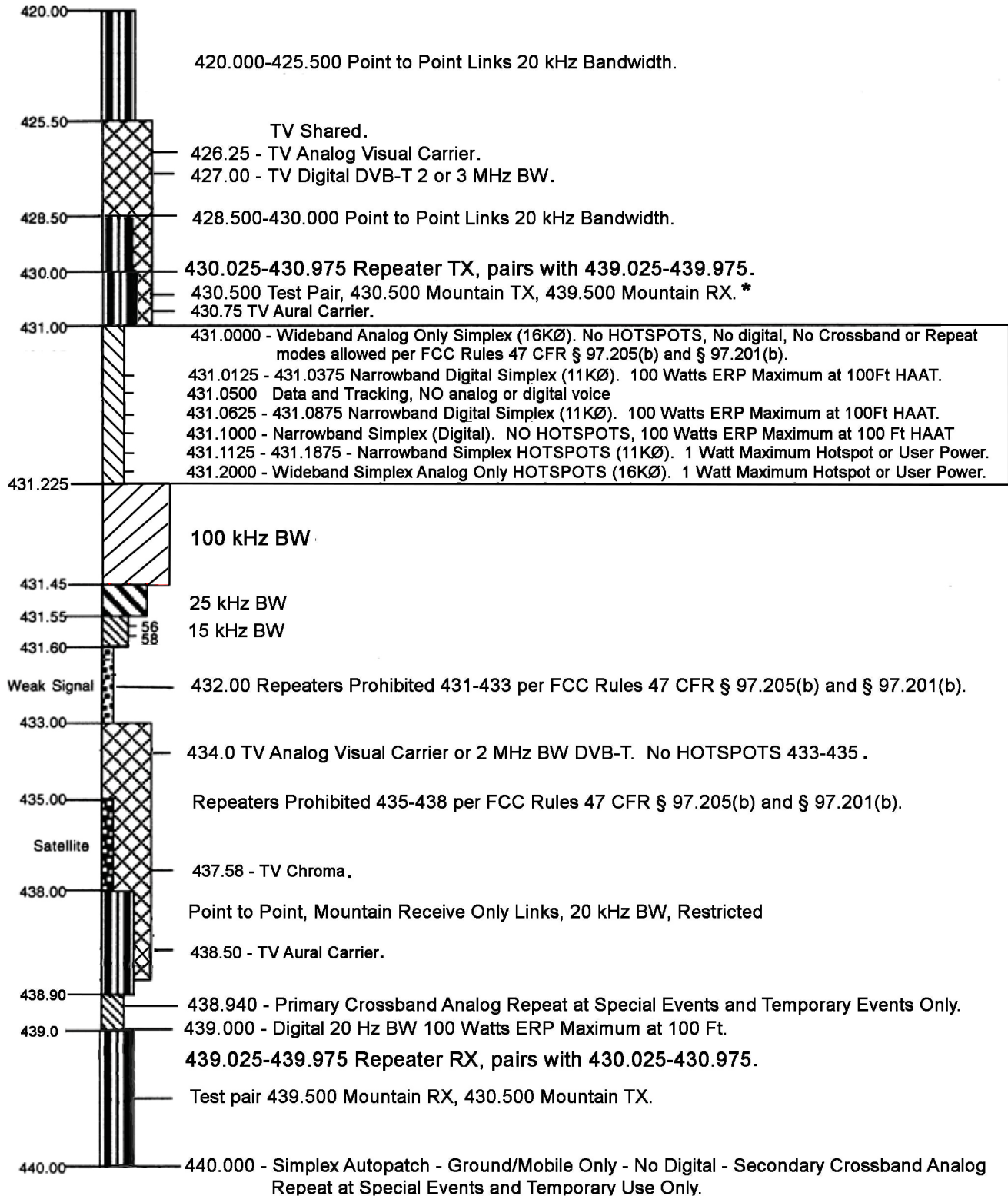




Southern California 420-440 MHz Bandplan and Usage
